these feelings are scattered throughout the book.

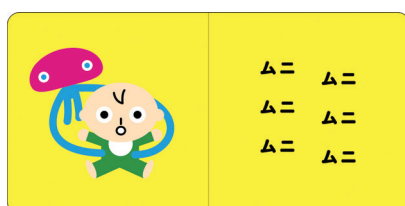


The story is very simple. The words repeat again and again in a simple rhythm.



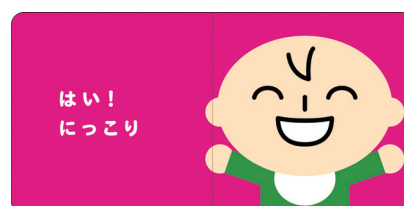
Munimuni Seijin ga Yattekita
